



Martha Barrios Mead was a passionate bilingual speech pathologist and diagnostician, and together with Maritza Morelli, she was a key architect in the vision behind Los Niños Primero. Martha made a career of her own as a bilingual speech pathologist, serving children in elementary schools in California, and later in Cobb County, Georgia. We were fortunate enough to witness her love for education and the Latino community in Atlanta. Martha passed away after a 3-year battle with cancer in 2017, all the while serving on our Board of Directors and as a volunteer dedicated to expanding and implementing Los Niños Primero's mission: creating lifelong learners in the preschool Latin American community in Georgia.

In 2018, as the first Los Niños Primero preschool students were college-aged and considering their academic futures, an endowment was established to cement Martha's legacy: the Martha Barrios Mead Scholarship.

Scholarship Description:

The Los Niños Primero Martha Barrios Mead Scholarship is designed to support Los Niños Primero participants in their pursuit of higher education. This scholarship is highly competitive and emphasizes financial need and academic merits and achievements.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must have participated in LNP as a student or volunteer for 2 years: a year of service is defined by serving at least 120 hours each year.
- Applicants must be enrolled as a 12th grade student with sufficient credits to graduate in the Spring of 2024 or currently enrolled as a full-/part-time in an accredited college, university, trade/technical school
- Applicants must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA based on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent) and submit an official school transcript as proof of GPA
- Applicants may not be a family member or employees of persons who are involved in the development, production, or selection of scholarship recipients for this scholarship
- The application process for First Time Applicants involves **two** rounds of interviews. Applicants must complete the following application and submit a video interview to the members of the Los Niños Primero Martha Barrios Mead Scholarship Committee (more information on page 5). The committee will contact the applicants who move onto the next round of in-person interviews.
